## The Association Cup 2022

For those interested in arriving early a .303 Rifle shoot will be conducted at a registered range on Friday October 28. All wishing to take part in this element of the event must be appropriately licensed, provide their own weapon (.303 rifles only) and ammunition, agree to all requirements of the appointed Range Officer and pay the additional fees for nomination.

Riders can nominate along with their troop, as an incomplete troop or individual and we will endeavor to match riders where required. Nomination fees are all inclusive and provide for stabling, powered camping and meals as summarised on the following program of events.
