All wishing to take part in this element of the event must be appropriately licensed, provide their own weapon (.303 rifles only) and ammunition, agree to all requirements of the appointed Range Officer and pay the additional fees for nomination.

### The Venue

Manilla Showgrounds is located on River Street Manilla, with the main entry available at the base of Court Street. Powered Camp sites are abundant and there are toilet and shower amenities available. Dogs must remain on a leash at all times on this facility. If you would prefer a motel stay, the Manilla Motel is a close walk away (book early) or there are a number of pubs within a few blocks of the grounds. Produce is available nearby at Hart Rural (Court Street) 8am to 5.30pm weekdays and 8am until midday Saturday. The local IGA is well stocked with groceries and a bottle shop and operates from 8am to 7pm weekdays (6pm weekends).
